



Crab

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make two big balls and flatten them into mound shapes by pressing them against the table. Next, put the flat sides of the mounds together to make the crab's body. Then make four fat ropes.



Pinch or roll the ropes into long cones to make the legs. Attach the legs to body, then bend each leg in the middle. Make two very short tubes to be the arms. For the claws, roll four large tubes and pinch the ends into points, then flatten one side to make them into half-circles.



Place the arms on the front of the crab's body. Attach the claws by placing two of your half-circles at the end of each arm as shown. Then make two small balls and two small cones.



To make the eyeballs, place the two balls on the skinny ends of the cones. Place them on the crab's head. Roll two tiny ropes and place one on each eyeball for pupils. Great job! It's hard to be crabby with such a cute friend!

School Bus

Level: Advanced

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Make a large rectangular cube for the main bus and a small rectangular cube for the front. For windows, make four small squares and two bigger rectangles. Roll one skinny rope.



Slope the top of the front and attach to the bus. Place the small windows on the side, and the two rectangular windows at the front and back. Add the rope to make a stripe. Next

roll two small balls, two tiny balls, and two skinny ropes. Make a flat rectangle for the door.



Place the door on the side of bus. Flatten the small balls with your finger to create tires and add the tiny balls as hubcaps. Then flatten your two ropes and place them at the front and back as bumpers.



Roll three more tiny balls. Put one on the roof for a warning light and two in the front for headlights. Now your bus is ready to go!

Monkey

Level: Advanced

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Make a ball and form it into an egg shape for the monkey's body. Make four short, fat ropes for arms and legs. Then make a circle and flatten it into an oval.



Place the flat oval on the body to make the chest. Make four balls and flatten them for the monkey's paws, then make four tiny circles and join them to the paws to make thumbs. Add the paws to the arms and legs, then attach to the body.



Make a small ball for the monkey's head. Make a circle and place it on the front of the head, then attach the head to the body. Make two small circles for eyes, and then add a tiny ball to each eye for pupils. Add two flat circles for ears. Make a small, thin rope for the mouth.



Place the eyes and mouth on the monkey's face. Roll a long thin rope for a tail and attach to the body. You've made a cute monkey friend. Now can you make him a banana?

Ice Cream Truck

Level: Advanced

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For the truck's body, make a large cube. Make smaller rectangular cube for the truck's front. For bumpers, make two skinny ropes. Then make two flat squares for the truck's windows.



Slope the top of the truck's front and attach it to the truck. Add the two windows and two

bumpers as shown. For the wheels, make two balls and flatten them, then add two tiny, flattened balls for hubcaps. Next make two tiny balls, one large ball and one cone.



Add the wheels to the truck, then attach the two tiny balls to the front as headlights. Flatten one side of the ball to make it look like a scoop of ice cream, then place the scoop on the cone.



Put the ice cream cone on the top of your truck, and decorate the sides of the truck with more ice cream treats. Yum! What's your favorite ice cream flavor?

Bike

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make two large flat circles for the bike's wheels. Make three long ropes for the frame of the bike.



Connect the three long ropes of the frame to the wheels as shown. For the pedals, make two very short ropes and join them in a "T" shape. For the chain, make a tube, flatten it, then pinch one end to make it skinnier than the other. Make a tube for the seat.



Roll the seat into a skinnier shape and set aside. For handlebars, make a rope and attach to frame above the front wheel. Then make a longer rope and connect to frame below the handlebars. Place the fat end of chain over this rope and the skinny end over the back wheel.

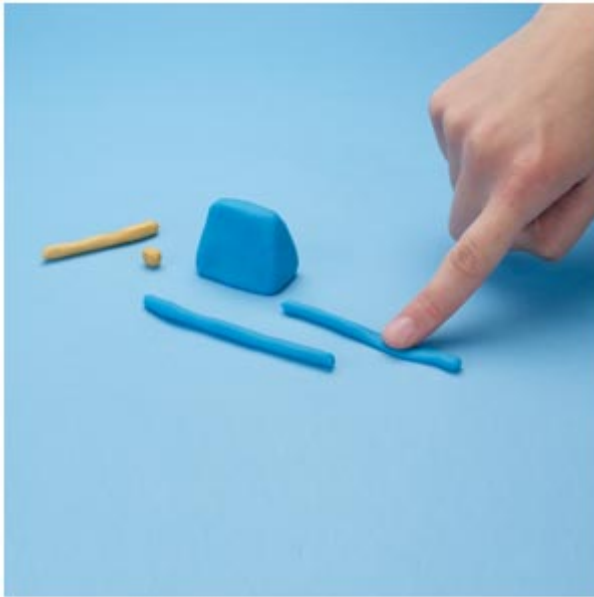


Place the seat on the frame above the rear wheel. Place the T-shaped pedals over the chain. You're done! Hey, what a cool bike!

Purse

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make a rectangle, then flatten two sides to make a triangle shape for the purse. Roll a long thin rope to make the seam, and a small ball for the clasp. Roll 2 long thin ropes to make the handles.



Flatten the ends of the handles. Bend one handle to make an upside down “U” and attach

it to one side of the purse. Place the long thin rope across the narrow end to make the seam. Roll 5 very short ropes and 1 small ball.



Place the clasp at the center of the seam. Bend the other handle and place it on the purse. Arrange the 5 short ropes into a flower shape and flatten to make petals. Flatten the small ball and place it at flower's center.



Place the flower on the side of your purse. How stylish! All you need now are some shoes to match.

Bulldozer

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make a rectangle. Flatten one end at an angle to form the bulldozer body. Make a smaller rectangle and place it on top for the cab. Roll out two fat ropes and flatten to make the treads.



Attach the treads to the side of the body. Make 10 tiny balls for the wheels. Roll 3 thin ropes, then make one rectangle. Pinch the ends of the rectangle up to make the shovel.



Flatten the wheels and place 5 on each tread. Use two ropes to connect the shovel to the front of the bulldozer. Place the last rope in front of the cab for a smoke stack. Make 4 flat squares for windows.



Place a window on each side of the cab. Terrific! Your bulldozer is ready for a big day of work!

Umbrella

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make flat half-circle. Pinch the edges of the straight side to make the bottom of your umbrella.



Make one long rope and 4 short ropes. Press the short ropes into curved shapes on your umbrella as shown.



Make a "U" shape at one end of the long rope for the umbrella's handle.



Attach the handle to your new umbrella. What a great umbrella. Now all you need is a little rain!

Sombrero

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Roll a cone with a rounded tip. Then make a flat circle. Pinch up the edges of the circle to make the sombrero's brim.



Place the cone on the brim. Roll two ropes. Then flatten a long rectangle.



Wrap the rectangle and the ropes around the top of your sombrero. Continue to decorate the hat by rolling more ropes. Pinch the ropes into zigzag patterns and press into the brim of your sombrero.



Bueno! That's one snazzy hat! What clothes can you make to go with your sombrero?

Bunny

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Roll a large ball and shape into an oval for the bunny's body. Roll 2 long ropes for his legs. Make a smaller ball for the head, pinching one side where his nose will go.



Place the bunny's head on top of the body. Take the long ropes and roll them up half-way to form the legs. Attach 1 leg to each side of the body. Make 2 short ropes and pinch one end of each. Attach these to the sides of the body for his front legs.



Roll 2 short ropes. Flatten them and shape them into ears by pinching one end. Roll 2 thinner ropes and flatten them onto the ears. Make three small balls for the eyes and nose.



Attach the narrow end of the ears to the top of the head. Place the eyes and nose on the head. Hurray for you! You made a bunny. How high can he hop?

Squirrel

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Roll a large ball, then shape into an oval for the body. Roll a smaller ball for the head and place on the body. To make the back legs, make two very short, thick pieces of rope, then pinch on end of each to form the feet.



Place the back legs on the body. Make two smaller front legs, shaping them like the back

ones. Make a flat oval. Make long rope for the tail, then form it into a curvy shape as shown.



Place the flat oval over the squirrel's belly, then place the front legs on either side of the body. Make 2 circles for the eyes. Make 2 smaller circles and place them on top of the eyes for the pupils. Make 2 small triangles for the ears.



Now just twist the balloon strings together and you're done! Great job – you've just made yourself a whole bunch of balloons!

Frog

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make a ball and shape into the frog's body. Make a half circle. Roll 2 pieces of rope for the back legs. Roll each back leg into a spiral half way.



Place the half circle across the front of the frog, leaving a space between the half circle and frog. Flatten the free end of the rope to form the frog's feet.



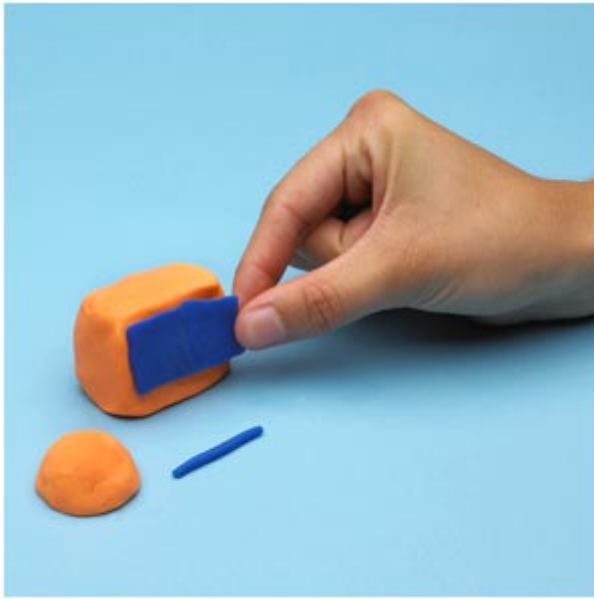
Attach a back leg to either side of the frog. Roll 2 small balls. Make 2 sets of circles for the eyes. Roll a short piece of rope. Make several small circles.



Attach balls to top of frog's head for the eyes. Place pupils on top of eyes. Break piece of rope in half and flatten. Shape and attach to frog for front legs. Place circles on frog's body. Roll another piece of rope and flatten. Place between space on front of frog and shape to make a tongue! Super duper! That is a very cool frog!

Computer
Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make a half circle for the monitor base. Make a square and shape into monitor. Make a flat square and flatten into rectangle. Place it across the front of the monitor for the screen. Roll a thin piece of rope.



Flatten rope and break in half. Place one half of rope across bottom of screen. Make 2 circles and place beneath screen. Make a rectangle for the keyboard. Place other half of

rope down the right side keyboard. Roll 3 more thin pieces of rope and lay across keyboard to make keys.



Roll a shorter piece of rope to place under keys to make a “space” bar. Roll a long, thin piece of rope. Make a ball and shape into mouse.



Attach rope to mouse and keyboard. Voila! That is one super Play-Doh computer!

Police Car

Level: Advanced

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make a rectangle and shape into car body. Make a smaller rectangle and place on top of car body. Make 4 circles for the tires.



Attach front wheels to car. Make 2 flat squares. Shape, and attach to sides of car for doors. Make 2 small pieces of rope. Attach rope to front and back of car for bumpers. Make a small rectangle for the emergency lights.



Attach emergency light to roof of car. Make flat rectangles and attach to make windshield and windows. Make 2 small circles and attach to front of car for headlights. Make 4 more circles and attach to tires for hubcaps. Make 2 small triangles. Attach one to hood of car.

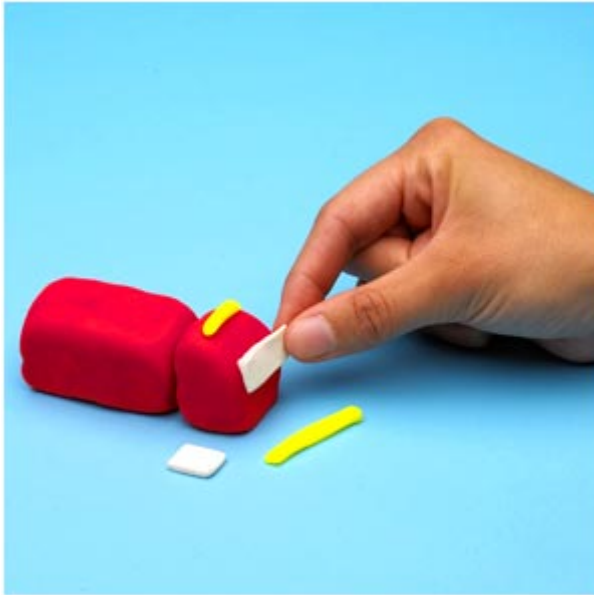


Attach second triangle to door of car. Holy cannoli! You have become quite the advanced creation creator!

Fire Truck

Level: Advanced

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Make a rectangle for the body of the truck. Make a square for the cab and attach to body. Roll a small piece of rope and place across top of cab for emergency lights. Make a flat rectangle and place across front of cab for windshield. Make a flat square for the window. Roll a thin piece of rope.



Place window on side of cab. Flatten rope and place across bottom of cab for front

bumper. Make 2 small circles and place above bumper for headlights. Make 4 balls and flatten for tires. Make a circle to place over each tire for the hubcaps. Attach a tire to each corner of the truck. Make 2 pieces of rope equal in size for the ladder.



Place rope across side of truck. Make two smaller pieces of rope and use them to secure ladder to truck. Make 2 triangles. Make a short, thick piece of rope and a very long piece of rope. Wrap the longer piece of rope in a spiral around the shorter rope to make the hose.



Place the hose on top of the truck, flattening slightly. Place a triangle on either side of the house to secure it to the truck. Way to go! You're becoming quite the Play-Doh creation champion!

Santa

Level: Advanced

Roll a small ball. Make a cone and flatten to make hat. Make a circle for the face. Roll a larger cone. Then, flatten the cone and shape to make a beard that will fit the face.



Attach beard to face, pinching and molding. Mold and attach pieces of Play-Doh for the

mustache and hair. Roll a small piece of rope and attach to bottom of hat. Attach ball to hat.



Make 2 small circles for the eyes. Make 2 circles for rosy cheeks. Add a small thin piece of rope for the mouth.

Bowling Pins

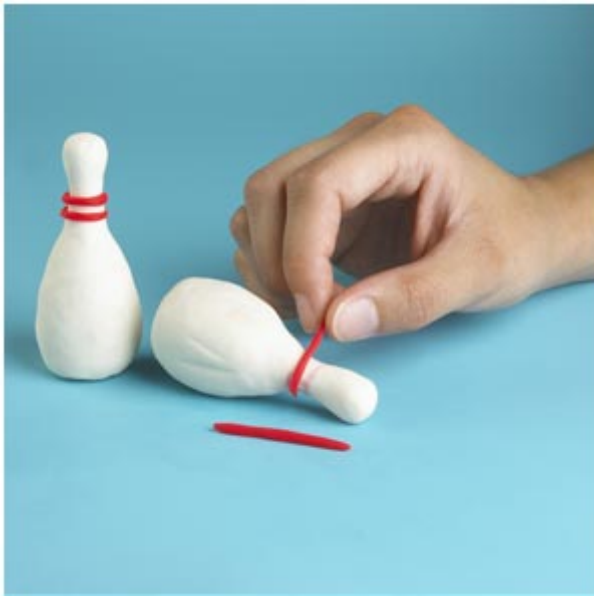

Roll 2 thick, medium-length ropes for bowling pins. Roll and shape one end thinner.



Continue to thin out end of pin until you have an upside down drumstick shape. Repeat for second pin. Roll 4 short, thin ropes. Place 2 ropes around to use as stripes.



Roll a medium-sized ball for the bowling ball. Roll 3 tiny balls and flatten them on to the ball as shown.



You've got talent to spare! Way to go making the bowling pins!

Flower

Level: Advanced

Roll 4 cones. Flatten and pinch to form petals.



Attach 3 petals at base, starting to form flower. Roll several small pieces of rope and

attach them together. Then attach to center of flower. Attach fourth petal to complete the flower.



Roll a cone into an and pinch to form a leaf.



Roll a piece of rope to be used for the stem. Attach the stem to base of flower. Attach leaf to the stem. What a green thumb you've got! That's a beautiful flower!

Lizard

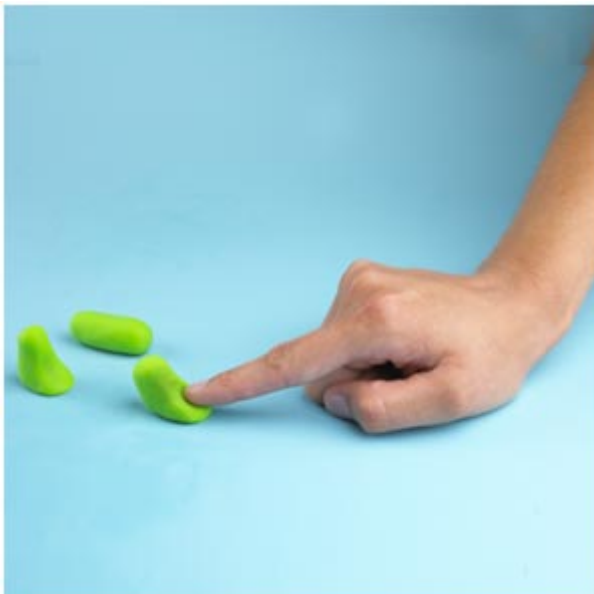

Roll a large oval for the body. Then roll a large cone for the tail.



Roll 4 short, thick pieces of rope and shape into legs as shown.



Attach tail to body. Try putting a couple of bends in the tail to make it look natural. Attach legs to body.



Roll a large, thick piece of rope. Bend into an “L” shape and attach to body for the head. Roll 2 balls. Attach 2 circles to each ball and place on top of head for the eyes. Roll a small, thin piece of rope and attach to head for mouth. Roll 2 small balls. Pinch to flatten and attach to back of head for spikes. Roll 2 short, thin pieces of rope and attach to tip of tail as shown. Leapin' lizards! You are well on your way to becoming a master PLAY-DOH artist!

Seahorse

For the seahorse's body, roll a large rope as shown, making one end longer and thinner. Keep the middle portion thickest, and the other end pointed. Roll 2 short ropes and make one small triangle.



Curl the long, thin end of rope to form the tail. Pinch the other end to shape into the seahorse's head and snout. Make a small, round indentation for the eye. Place the triangle at the base of the head for a fin. Flatten the two small ropes.



Place the flattened ropes along the top of head and spine for fins as shown. Roll a small ball and flatten it for white of eye. Place in indentation. Roll a smaller ball and flatten on top for the pupil.



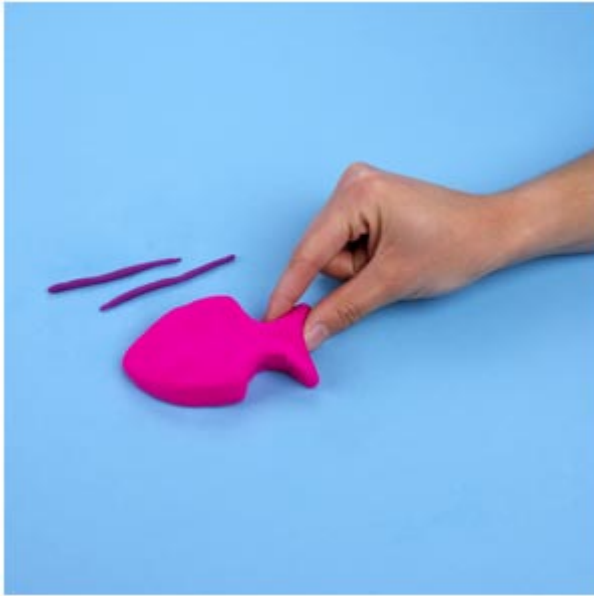

Tropical Fish

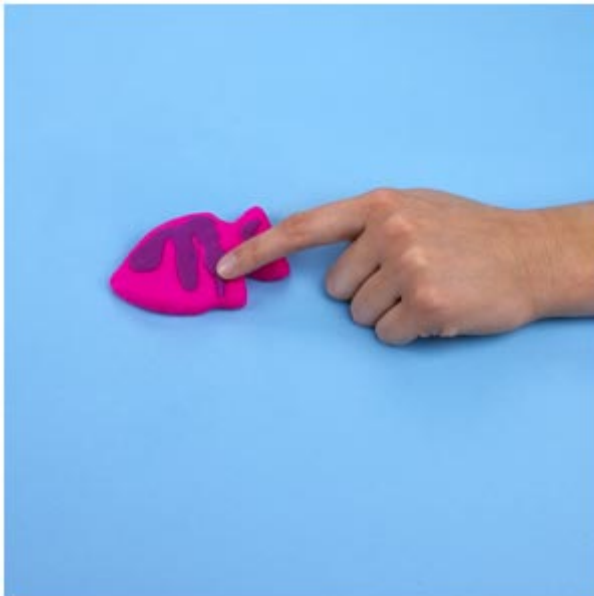

Roll a large flat oval. Pinch one end to form the tail. Roll 2 long, thin ropes.



Place pieces of rope on fish and flatten out as shown.



Make a small triangle and flatten along edge for mouth. Roll small ball and flatten for eye. Roll an even smaller ball, flatten on top of eye for pupil.



Roll several balls of various sizes to use for air bubbles. Amazing! You've just made a tropical fish!

Corn on the Cob

Roll a large oval. Making one end thicker, shape to form an ear. Roll lots of small balls to be used for the kernels.



Press balls onto ear in rows to make kernels, covering entire ear.



Roll 3 large cones, then flatten and shape for husk.



Place widest end of husk at the fat end of the corn. Shape husk along ear, folding back the tips slightly as shown. Great job! You've just made corn on the cob!

Lobster

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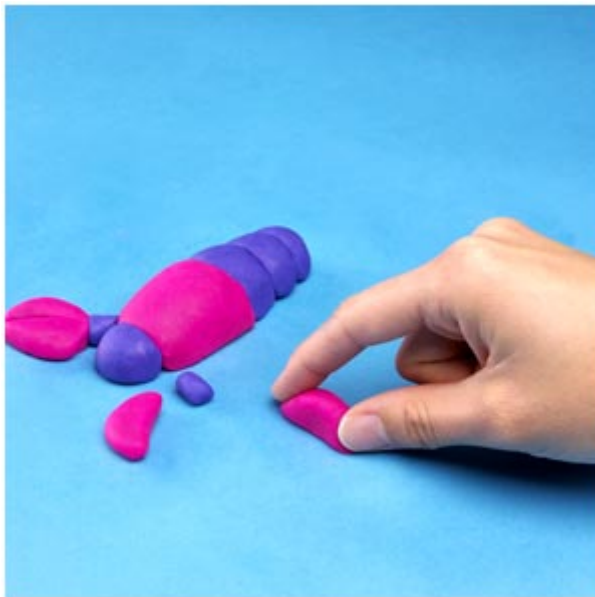

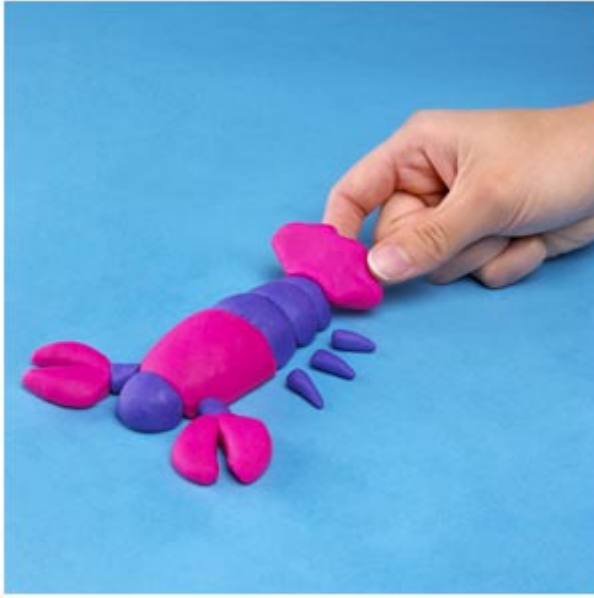
Roll a short, thick rope. Roll 3 balls, making each one a little smaller than the one before. Flatten balls slightly on two sides and form together in a row. Roll another ball and shape into a half circle.



Connect ball to rope and shape for head and body.



Connect row of circles to body. Roll two short ropes and 2 sets of half circles. Attach and assemble to form claws.



Roll 6 small cones. Place 3 on either side of tail. Roll a ball and slightly flatten to form a fan shape for end of tail. Attach cones to tail. Roll 2 small, thin ropes. Form a Y to make base for eyes. Roll 2 small balls and place on top of Y. Roll 2 smaller balls and flatten on to eyes for pupils. Unbelievable! You've got a lot of patience to make such a cute lobster!

American Flag

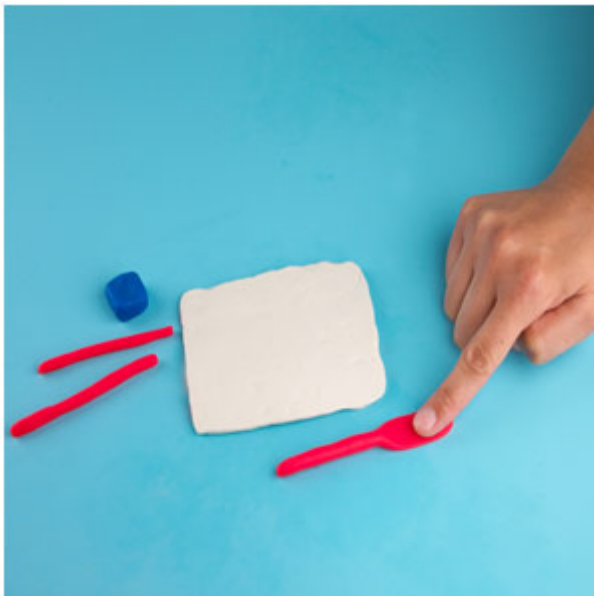

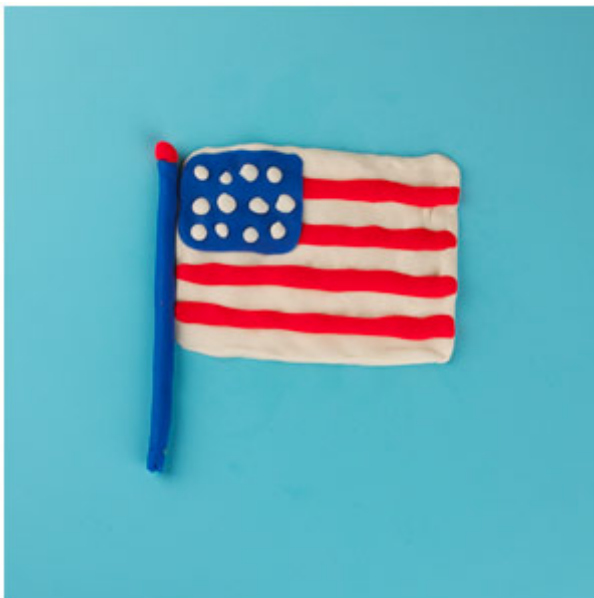
Shape a square and flatten into a rectangle.



Shape a smaller square. Roll several pieces of rope and flatten.



Lay flattened ropes across rectangle. Flatten smaller square into smaller rectangle and place over the stripes on the top left corner of the rectangle. Roll small balls for the stars. Roll a long piece of rope and ball for the flagpole.



Flatten balls onto smaller rectangle for stars. Attach ball to top of rope and attach along side of flag. Way to go! That's a grand 'ole flag!

Cat

Level: Advanced

Roll an oval to use for the cats head. Roll a larger oval for the cats body, flattening one end as shown in picture.



Roll 2 short ropes to be used for the front legs. Roll 2 more ropes, slightly longer and pinch into an L shape to be used for the hind legs.



Attach legs as shown, placing body on top of two front legs, and attaching two hind legs.



Roll small oval and split in half. Use halves to form ears as shown. Roll 2 ovals for the eyes, placing 2 smaller ovals horizontally for the pupils. Roll a small circle for the nose. Roll a small, thin rope and shape for the mouth. Wow! Great job! You just made a cat!

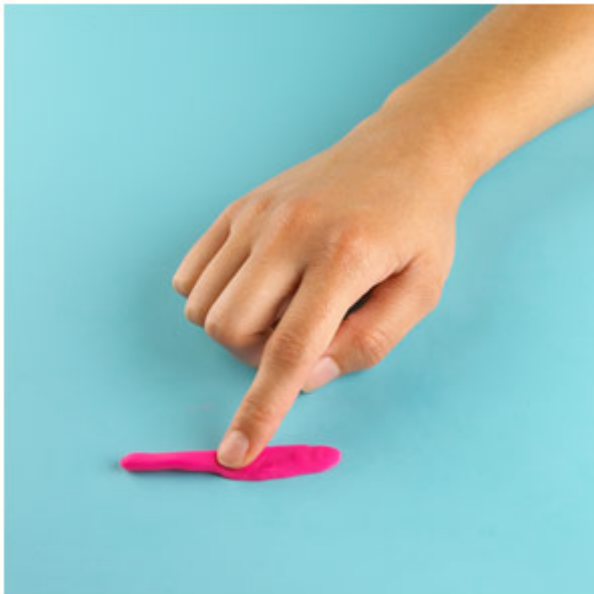
Roll 3 ropes of equal length and diameter.



Connect the ropes at one end and braid the ropes together.



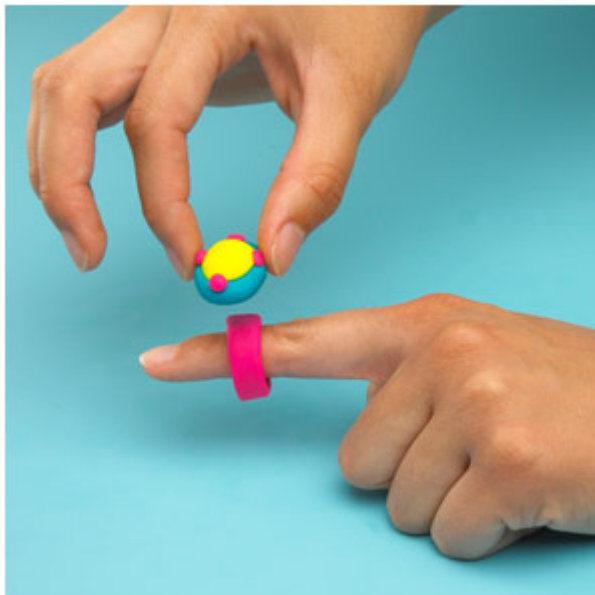
Connect the two ends to form the bracelet. If you want to wear it, you should connect the ends after youve wrapped it around your wrist.



Roll a short thick rope (long enough to fit around your finger). Flatten and connect both ends to form band.



Roll a thick circle. Roll a ball smaller than circle and place on top of circle.



Place circle on top of band. Add small circles around the flattened ball to create tiny jewels. Woo hoo! That was awesome! You just made PLAY-DOH jewelry!

Teacup

Start with a large, thick circle and start pinching from the center to the sides to form a bowl.



Continue to widen the center, trying to keep even thickness all the way around.



Flatten a circle slightly larger than the teacup for the saucer. Place the teacup on saucer. Roll a short, thicker rope and attach to side of teacup for the handle.



Roll a long, thin rope and attach in waves on teacup and saucer. Make 2 small cubes for sugar cubes! Excellent job! You just made a teacup!

Easter Basket

Cut long, thin ropes into small pieces to use for the grass. Attach the handle. Roll another long rope. Roll small-to-medium-sized balls and shape into eggs.



Rest eggs on the grass. Attach long, thin rope to basket. Roll more eggs.



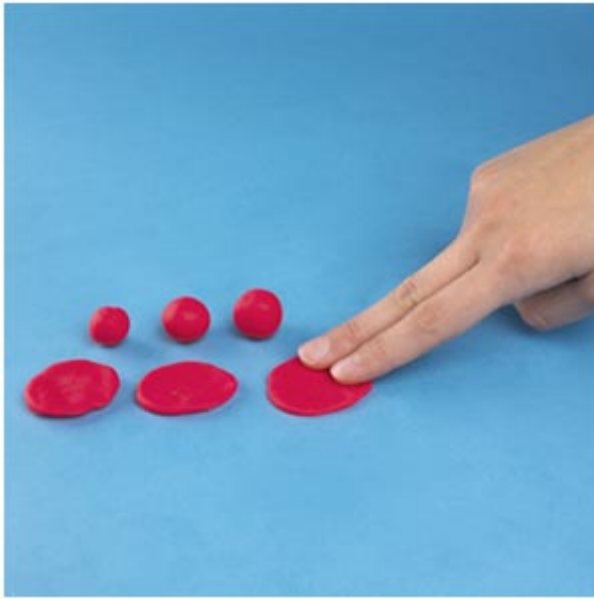
Place all the eggs in the basket. Wasnt that fun? You just made a beautiful spring basket!

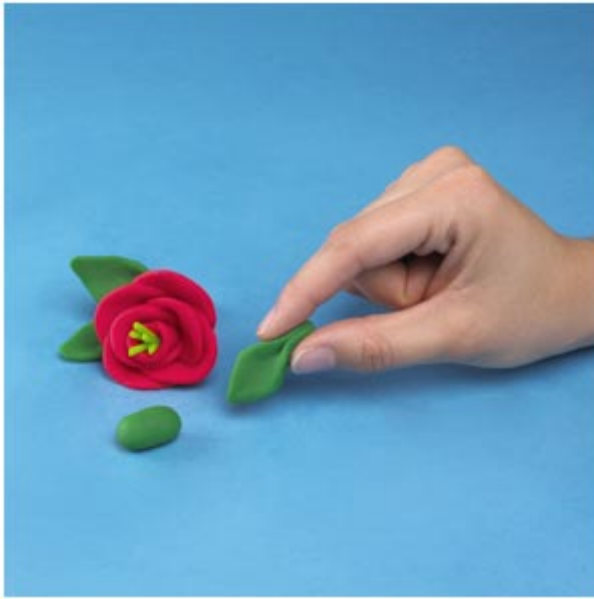


Make 6 balls. Each one should be slightly larger than the one before it. Flatten each ball into a circle to use for the petals.

petal around the anther. Wrap the next largest petal around the first one. Continue wrapping petals to form the rose flower.



Roll 3 ovals, then flatten and shape them to use for the leaves, attaching them at the base of the flower.
