

Flip-Flops Level: Beginner

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make two long ropes and two fat tubes. Flatten the tubes into thick, flat oval shapes to make the bottoms of your flip-flops.



Flatten the ropes, then pinch them in the middle to make them into "V" shapes. These will be the flip-flop's straps.



To make your first flip-flop, place the pointy "V" part of the strap at one end of the flip-flop's bottom. Next, attach the ends of the straps to the flip-flop's sides as shown.



Finally, attach the strap for your second flip-flop. You're done! Now those are some fashionable flip-flops!

Lemon Slice Level: Beginner

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Roll two skinny ropes and four cones. Flatten the edges and tops of the cones into wedges.



Place the four wedges side by side to make a half-circle. Flatten the two ropes by pressing on them with your fingers. Next, roll three tiny balls.



Squeeze the tiny balls so they become pointed on one end, like seeds. Place one fat rope on top of the other to make the lemon rind.



Wrap the rind around the curved side of your wedges. Place the seeds on top of the wedges. Ta-dah! You just made a zesty piece of lemon.

Sand Castle Level: Beginner

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Make a large cube and a large tube to be the castle towers. Then press out a large flat oval to be the base for your castle.



Place the towers on the base, then make lots of tiny cubes and place them around the tops of the towers. Make a short rope and a flat square with rounded edges.



Pinch up the corners of the square to make the end of a shovel. Next attach the rope as a handle. Make some tiny, flat squares to be windows and a larger flat rectangle to be the door to your castle.



Place the door and windows on the castle and make a blob to be the sand in your shovel. Super job! Are you this good at building real sand castles?

Smile

To make the mouth, roll the short rope into a long, thin rope.



Place the long thin rope at one end of the circle, curving it into a smiling mouth. Flatten the two balls into oval-shaped eyes.



Place the eyes onto the circle, then smile! You've made a happy smiling PLAY-DOH face!

Paintbrush Level: Beginner

Roll a fat rope with one pointy end for the paint brush's stick. To make the bristles, roll a short fat rope and pinch each end into a point. Make a flat rectangle.



Attach the bristles to the stick. Wrap the flat rectangle around the handle just below the bristles.



Make a ball and then flatten it into the shape you want to make your blob of paint.



Place the paint near the bristles and Voila! You've created a PLAY-DOH masterpiece!

Soda Bottle Level: Beginner

Using the basic shapes key above, follow the easy step-by-step instructions below to make your PLAY-DOH creation. Keep practicing, and you'll get better at making all of the shapes. Use our color suggestions, or try your own! The less shapes you use, the more simple your creation. The more shapes you add, the more complex it becomes.



Roll a fat cylinder that is slightly thinner on one end for the bottle. Roll a short rope. Roll three balls, one slightly smaller than the other two.



To shape a curve into the bottle, place two fingers above the fat end of the cylinder, then press in gently as you roll it. Stand the bottle up. Flatten the brown balls and stack them

on top to make the bottle's lip. Flatten the yellow ball with your thumb and pinch the edges up to make a cap.



Squeeze the ends of the short rope to make an "S"-shape for the bottle's brand logo.



Place the logo on the bottle and you're done! You'll amaze your friends with your latest PLAY-DOH creation.

Strawberry Level: Beginner


Make a ball, shaping it so that the top is a little bit pointed. Then roll several short ropes with pointed ends.



Place your ropes pointy-side out to make a star shape. Save one rope to place in the middle of the star. This is your strawberry stem. Roll several small circles to be strawberry seeds.



Place the stem on the rounded end of your strawberry. Press the seeds flat into the sides of your strawberry.



Great job! It's as beautiful as a real strawberry! What other fruit shapes can you make?

Lipstick

Make 2 rectangles for the case of the lipstick; one should be slightly longer than the other. Roll a cylinder for the lipstick.



Press one end of the cylinder to form an angle. Make a short skinny rope and a longer, fatter rope. Flatten the ropes into bands.



Place the flat end of the lipstick onto the longer half of the case. Wrap the fatter band around the base of the lipstick. Wrap the thinner rope around the shorter half of the case.



Excellent job! Your new PLAY-DOH lipstick creation is just fabulous!

Acorn

Attach stem to top of grape cluster. Attach a leaf to either side of the stem. Pinch end of leaves to form points.







Hockey Stick Level: Beginner

Roll a small ball for the puck. Roll a long piece of rope for the hockey stick. Start to flatten the rope.



Continue to flatten stick, making the bottom slightly wider. Slightly bend the end of the stick to form the "blade" of the stick. Flatten puck into a circle. Make a short piece of rope for the top of the stick. Roll a thin piece of rope and flatten to use as tape.



Shape small piece of rope into a rectangle and attach to top of hockey stick. Wrap tape around the blade.



Cool! You just made a hockey stick! Now to work on that slap shot!

Worm

Roll 2 short, thin ropes and place on top of head for antennae.



Pat yourself on the back! You just made a worm!

Baseball bat Level: Beginner




Roll a thick rope and shape into a bat. Roll a ball and flatten into a thick circle.



Attach circle to small end of the bat. Roll a long, thin rope to be used for the grip.



Starting at the very end of the handle, wrap the rope around the bat 5 or 6 times to make the grip.



You're ready to hit a home run! Great job making a baseball bat!

Hairbrush Level: Beginner

Roll a short, thick piece of rope for the handle. Make a circle for head of the brush and make a smaller circle for the bristles.



Flatten one end of the handle. Shape brush head and bristles into ovals.



Place brush head on top of bristles. Press down gently to attach. Attach flat end of handle to brush head.



Very good! You just made a hairbrush!




Wrap rope around tree for garland.

Flatten a piece of rope across both legs and both arms. Attach a piece of rope to form a smile. Flatten 3 balls down Gingerbread Man's belly for buttons. Flatten 2 circles for the eyes.

Roll 2 small thin pieces of rope and attach together in a "V" shape. Attach "V" to top of face for antennae. Roll another piece of rope.



Attach rope to face for a mouth. Roll another piece of rope and attach down the center of the ladybug's back. Excellent job! I hope your fabulous PLAY-DOH ladybug brings you lots of good luck!

Leaf

Make 3 small triangles and place on pumpkin for eyes and nose. Make a rope and press into a crescent moon shape and place on the pumpkin for the mouth.



Print out instructions



Roll out a flat circle, then vary the shape of the edges for the egg white. Shape a round mound and place it in the center to form the yolk.



Roll 2 short, thick ropes and press out into imperfect rectangles to form bacon strips. Roll out very thin ropes of varying lengths. Flatten onto bacon strip.



Crinkle the bacon to help it look more realistic.
